



We are pleased to announce that we are now able to offer DRIVE-UP visits for our families and residents at St. Johnland Nursing Center. This is a wonderful way to have a quick visit with your loved one after so many months. We appreciate your strict adherence to the guidelines we put in place for the safety of your loved one.

St. Johnland Drive-Up Guidelines:

- Visits will last for 10 minutes. **PLEASE BE ON TIME**, as we do not have much room built in around visits in order to allow as many as possible in one day. If you are late, please understand that your stop time will remain the same.
- You will be directed to the front entrance for our Nursing Center. For all Kipp residents, you are directed to the Adult Day Care Program driveway entrance.
- Please place the name of your resident on your dashboard in large writing, so we can easily see who you are and confirm your attendance.
- Residents will be in the entrance vestibule of the assigned location: they will be under the Porte cochere.
- **VISITORS MUST REMAIN IN THEIR CARS** and obey social distancing rules at all times with our staff and residents. Please turn off your vehicle during the visit to minimize noise distractions and exhaust fumes.
- You will be contacted to arrange for your visit.
- **Each resident will be allowed one visit** until all residents have had an opportunity. If more than one family member signs up, the first relative on the schedule will be honored. **Please coordinate with your family** to ensure everyone gets to visit.
- You may have as many people as you like in a car – just please remember, **no one will be permitted to exit the vehicle for any reason during the visit.**
- **PLEASE NOTE: In the event of inclement weather or other circumstances beyond our control, we will contact you by phone to reschedule your visit.**

We are thrilled to be able to offer this DRIVE-UP visit opportunity to our families and residents, and we appreciate your patience and understanding as we allow all families their opportunity.
