**Residents and Family Members:**

**The holiday season is approaching once again, and time to remind everyone of our safety standards with regard to decorations.**

- 1. All holiday lighting must be in good condition and have a UL approval tag.**
- 2. All decorations must be fire retardant and have a tag or documentation to confirm.**
- 3. Cut wreaths or trees are not permitted in the facility.**
- 4. Live trees that are potted are allowable, but cannot be decorated with any lighting.**
- 5. Lights and decorations are not to be hung from the ceiling, furniture or walls.**
- 6. Decorations should not be excessive in any area.**
- 7. Artificial trees in resident rooms are to be a size that does not interfere with resident's care. (for example a full sized tree is not allowed)**
- 8. Extension cords are not permitted.**

**The safety of our residents, visitors and staff is a top priority to us. Please help everyone to have a safe and happy holiday season.**
